Effective September 22, 2021, and as mandated by the Province of Ontario, the Brooke-Alvinston-Inwood Community Centre Complex will require all persons entering the arena or community centre to be double vaccinated. Proof must be provided.

To be considered double vaccinated, the person must have obtained their second shot 14 days prior to entry date at the arena / complex. This will include all spectators (12+) and players 18 (+). Masks and social distancing rules will apply to everyone.

In relation to the ice surface for hockey, the exception to the vaccination rule will be active players (during the specified time slot only) under 18 years of age, that being, 17 years old and below. **No Exceptions**

In relation to the ice surface for figure skating, the exception to the vaccination rule will be active skaters (during the specified time slot only) under 18 years of age, that being, 17 years old and below. **No Exceptions**

The Municipality will be monitoring the doors for proof of double vaccination. The organization booking the event space or the ice will be responsible for contact tracing of the admitted individuals.

The Municipality recognizes that these restrictions may be difficult and not to everyone's approval. It is our goal to provide a safe environment for all our players and families and to follow the provincially mandated policy. The Municipality is requesting compliance.

Failure to show ID and proof of vaccine, wear a mask or persons displaying disrespect to the Municipal staff, including those at the entry door at any point or any volunteers, will result in loss of ice for the organization for a minimum of two weeks without refund.

**Non compliance cannot and will not be tolerated.**

Other key points (related to ice events or recreational activities including pickle ball):

- 1) The back entry doors will be locked with entry only allowed through the front door; please advise any team personnel or players to not allow anyone entry via this door. The doors are monitored and unauthorized entry will result in lost ice time
- 2) The Municipality can allocate each team entry to the facility 30 minutes before and 30 minutes after their practice / game scheduled
- 3) The doors will be locked 5 minutes after the organization's ice time begins.
