2019-2020 Season Format

- LMLL will move to a nine (9) game seeding rather than the six (6) game seeding used in recent years.
- The regular season will consist of the 9 seeding games and 11 addition games which will be scheduled against like ability opponents.
- Playoff format will be discussed next meeting; however, there was mention that the consolation round may not continue next year.
- LMLL would like an update on teams ASAP. The scheduling meeting is September 24 (October 8 for Novice), therefore this is the absolute latest time to submit this information. However, sharing earlier allows for better planning for this season.
- League fees will continue to be \$70 per team for this upcoming season season.

Tiering of LMLL

- ELMHA has shared our motion from our AGM in support of tiering of LMLL in the future.
- There were some significant concerns at the onset of the discussion, I believe because some misinterpreted that we voted to tier our teams for this upcoming season. It was clarified that we are suggesting a direction for the league, rather than going rogue against current league rules.
- LMLL has agreed to further discuss and explore this idea this year; any change to organizing the league would require a motion at the AGM.
- Concerns shared for our consideration include:
- a. Many/most centers only have one LL team, so we need to consider how this influences tiering.
- b. An AGM motion does not necessarily represent the beliefs of an entire membership.
- c. Strathroy expressed support of the tiering concept, but concern about finding coaches for the "C" division team(s).
- d. Lambton Shores expressed concerns about player retention for the "C" level teams.
- e. what tiering is already planned for Novice and Atom?

Suggestions:

• ELHMA form an ad hoc committee for this season to explore tiering at the local league level. This committee would investigate other local leagues that tier in Ontario and perhaps make a plan to work with another association or two to explore tiered exhibition games this season.

- Possible questions to explore:
- f. How and when would we conduct the selection/tiering process?
- g. How can practice time be used to explore the value of tiering will still allowing individual teams to develop as a team?
- h. How do we continue to collect data/information from our players and their families?

Examples: Do we measure possession time per player; count puck touches; opinion surveys?

- 4. What are effective line up adjustments that a coach can make throughout the season to encourage player development and team success?
- 5. ELMHA offers additional player development sessions lead by Scott Jones (TPH/SJPPD) and Paul Burgess (goalie clinic). What value do these services offer to team? What is my role as a coach with these player development sessions?
- 6. Name 5 adjectives to describe how you would like your team to play. As a team or a group, choose an adjective and then design a practice drill to support your players in learning to play this way.
