Enhanced Vaccine Certificate Requirements

Watford Community Arena

With the recent release of the provincial enhanced vaccine certificate, the entry requirements for the Watford Community Arena will be changing to help ensure the safety of our facility users.

Starting Monday, December 6, 2021, an enhanced vaccine certificate QR code must be presented to the screening staff at the door when attempting to enter the facility. Printed or photocopied vaccine receipts <u>without a QR code</u> will no longer be accepted.

ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF VACCINATION

- Province of Ontario enhanced vaccination certificate saved on a handheld device such as a phone or tablet. A photo of the QR Code, copy of a PDF or file containing the QR Code saved in a wallet or health app are acceptable.
- ✓ A printed copy of the individuals Province of Ontario enhanced vaccination certificate QR code.
- Regardless of the method of presenting the QR code, the code must be of high enough quality to be readable and verifiable by the Verify Ontario app. QR codes that will not scan will not be accepted and entry will be denied.
- Medical exemptions are still valid and must meet the provincial criteria. Please see the link below for more information.

WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTABLE

X A printed receipt from an individual's first or second dose vaccination, whether obtained during their appointment or through the provincial website, that does not contain the individual's enhanced QR code.

NOTE: Effective November 1, 2021 Proof of vaccination is required for persons 12 or older entering the facility for any purpose.
